

### 3. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

#### (d) Courtenay Street

John Hammond representing the residents of Courtenay Street spoke about their concerns that the road widening designation was still in place. While the road surface of Courtenay Street needed upgrading, the residents were reluctant to draw this to attention with the designation remaining. There was a traffic safety issue for children crossing the road. He said that they had appreciated the Board's support over this matter in the past.

A further matter of concern to residents was the overgrown state of the Council property on the corner of Westminster and Courtenay Streets. With the assistance of the Board, residents could see the opportunity for a road reserve, emulating the Packe Street Reserve.

The Board **decided:**

1. That enquiries be made as to the reason for the road widening designation on Courtenay Street still being in place, and to request its uplifting.
2. That a report be provided for the 3 May 2000 meeting on the status and condition of the section on the corner of Westminster and Courtenay Streets.
