

10. COMMUNITY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

The Board **resolved** that the recommendations of the Community Affairs Committee meeting held on 21 March 2000 be adopted as follows:

10.1 Parks Area Plan (Spreydon Ward) Submissions Report

That the Parks Unit:

1. Review the mowing programme for areas where the grass has been left higher, such as in the woodland and riverbank reserves areas.
2. Include reference to linkage with other plans in future parks area plans.
3. Remove the reference to access through the Addington Cemetery being undesirable in the next edition of the plan.
4. Review the future uses of the north-west and northern corners of Barrington Park.
5. Make any unsafe play equipment in Rydal Reserve safe, and to investigate whether or not the playground here should be upgraded.
6. Consider a planning exercise for Simeon Park to determine requirements.

10.2 Big SK8 Out – April School Holidays

To allocate \$650 from its 1999/2000 Discretionary Funds to the Recreation and Arts Team (Leisure Unit) for the staging of skate workshops during the April school holidays.

10.3 Turning Point 2000 Request for Funding

1. That the request for funding be declined.
