



6. **EXHIBITION: TREASURES FROM CHRIST CHURCH,
OXFORD COLLECTIONS**

Messrs Tony Preston, Director of the Robert McDougall Art Gallery, and David Chin, Marketing and Publicity Officer, spoke to the report, and provided a Marketing and Publicity Plan. Presented for the first time in New Zealand, the exhibition will feature very rare Old Master drawings and silver and silver-gilt treasures from a world-renowned collection. The exhibition will showcase works from the 16th, 17th and 18th centuries with a combined worth of NZ\$50 million, which is being indemnified by the Government through the Ministry of Arts, Culture and Heritage.
