3. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

(b) Oxford Terrace Restaurant and Bar Owners – Windbreaks on Oxford Terrace

A deputation of Oxford Terrace restaurant and bar owners, headed by Robert Mercer, Antony Gough and Alan Cowie, addressed the Committee on their proposal for the erection of windbreaks in front of their respective premises between the City Mall and Armagh Street.

The erection of windbreaks would allow them to maximise their outside dining facilities, to the benefit of tourism. They were now seeking some positive guidelines from the Council on how the structures could be proceeded with at an early date.

The Committee **decided** that a subcommittee comprising Councillors Crighton and Corbett, along with two Councillors from the City Services Committee, meet with Council staff to prepare a report on the issue of windbreak structures.
