



2. COMMENCEMENT OF PROCEEDINGS TO CREATE A PEDESTRIAN MALL IN CHESTER STREET BETWEEN PARK TERRACE AND CRANMER SQUARE

In accordance with a recommendation contained in clause 2 of the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board's report to the present Council meeting, to consider and if thought fit to adopt the following resolutions:

- “1. That, pursuant to section 336 of the Local Government Act 1974, the Christchurch City Council resolves, by way of Special Order, that the part of Chester Street between Park Terrace and Cranmer Square shown on the plan attached be declared a pedestrian mall.*
- 2. That the driving or parking of any vehicle or the riding of any animals be prohibited between the hours of 9:30am and 2:00pm Monday to Friday on a school day subject to the following exceptions and conditions:*
 - (a) Trade and other vehicles (including those operated by service authorities) of any class may enter the Mall at specified times if authorised by the City Streets Manager or Parking Manager.*
 - (b) Street cleaning and rubbish collection vehicles operated by the Christchurch City Council or its nominated contractor may enter the Mall at any time.*
 - (c) Any vehicle or specified class of vehicle that has entered the Mall under any section of this special order must not be parked for a longer period than is necessary for its driver to carry out his or her business or for the period of any emergency.*
 - (d) Nothing in this Special Order shall be deemed to prohibit or restrict the use of the Mall by any fire appliance, ambulance or other vehicle where it is necessary for that appliance, ambulance or other vehicle to enter the Mall or portion thereof for the protection of human life or of property.*
- 3. That the Council Secretary be authorised to give public notice that the foregoing resolutions will be submitted to an ordinary meeting of the Council to be held on Thursday 28 September 2000, for confirmation by way of Special Order.”*
