



**13. SKATEBOARD, IN LINE SKATING AND FREESTYLE BMX STRATEGY
– ADDITIONAL NEEDS AND BUDGETARY INFORMATION**

The Leisure Manager and Parks Manager reported on the budgetary implications of the Skateboard, In-Line Skating and Freestyle BMX Strategy, in response to the request made at the April 2000 meeting of the Council. The report also outlined the needs for freestyle BMX cyclists and the steps which had been taken to address some of the problems which had arisen at the new skateboard facilities in Jellie and St Albans Parks.

The report advised that the Skateboard, In-Line Skating and Freestyle BMX Strategy will be presented to the Committee in September when the needs of freestyle of BMX cyclists and for clubhouses associated with skate facilities have been incorporated in the strategy.

The Committee **decided**:

1. That the information be received.
2. That staff report further with recommendations for overcoming the present conflict between different users of these facilities.
