



## 1. WARD BOUNDARIES

The purpose of the meeting was to allow the Board to reconsider possible ward boundary changes, which had been previously approved by the Board at a meeting with the Hagley-Ferrymead Community Board on 29 June 2000. At a subsequent meeting of the Strategy and Resources Committee meeting on 15 August 2000 some Board members had expressed a preference for the retention of the present ward boundaries, and in view of this the Committee had asked the Board to hold a further meeting to confirm or otherwise its support for the changes proposed.

The Board **decided** to confirm its previous recommendations regarding boundary changes as agreed with the Hagley-Ferrymead Community Board on 29 June 2000, and as confirmed by the Board at its 1 August 2000 meeting, as follows:

- “1. *The area described as the Sydenham Business District and an area of four mesh blocks in Waltham be transferred from the Hagley ward to the Heathcote ward.*
2. *The Avoca Valley area be transferred from the Heathcote ward to the Ferrymead ward.”*

It was also **decided** to request a report on future options for adjustments between the boundaries of Spreydon and Heathcote, including population, new housing, etc to the next appropriate Board meeting.
