

17. NEW BRIGHTON ROAD: PEDESTRIAN REFUGE ISLAND



At the request of the Area Engineer, a report asking the Board to recommend to the City Services Committee the installation of a pedestrian refuge island, relocation of a bus stop and the introduction of parking restrictions at the Kate Sheppard Retirement Village in New Brighton Road, was withdrawn. An alternative proposal is to be reported to the Board's meeting on 29 January 2001. The Board **decided** that the Community Advocate investigate the use of the City Scene or the Pegasus Post to inform the community of the correct driving procedures for using flush median turning zones.
