

### 3. FENDALTON ROAD TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT RAILWAY (SUPPLEMENTARY REPORT)

The Traffic Engineer spoke to a tabled report outlining an issue associated with the installation of the cycleway traffic signals on Fendalton Road at the railway crossing. Unfortunately the required bans on parking on the Fendalton Road west approach to the cycleway crossing point had to date not been resolved on by the Council.

The Board's input was being invited as a prelude to the matter being considered by the City Services Committee.

The need to have regard to the Council's October decision on Fendalton Road was highlighted and various options to the one proposed in the officer's report were discussed.

The Board **decided**:

1. To recommend to the City Services Committee that:
  - (a) The proposed plan be circulated to the affected residents.
  - (b) The stress point of the cycleway crossing Fendalton Road be painted red.
2. To advise the Committee that the plan, as shown, was supported by the Board as a temporary measure only.
3. To remind the Committee of the decisions made on Fendalton Road by the Council at its October meeting, especially the option relating to an off-road cycleway.
