3. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

NATIVE PLANT DESIGN GUIDE

Di Lucas advised the Committee that in the past she had been associated with the production of three booklets on the Canterbury Plains and one for the Port Hills. The booklets provided information on different plants found in the area.

As a result, it had been suggested to her that it would be helpful to take the booklets further by providing how to use the plants.

Book 1 would be entitled 'Native Plant Design Guide' and would contain information and sketches on how such plants might be used in different locations around properties.

Book 2 would be entitled 'Ferns of Christchurch – A Design Guide'.

Funding had initially been sought from Community Boards, but it had been suggested that, given it was a Christchurch-wide project, it was a metropolitan matter and any funding should come from the Council itself.
