

### 13. “GENERATIONS TOGETHER” WORKING PARTY

The Leisure Manager reported, updating the Committee on the progress of the Generations Together Working Party in meeting its goal to encourage better use of Council reserves by promoting activities that will bring people of different ages together, celebrating all generations in the city.

The Committee **decided** to adopt the following recommendations of the working party:

1. That the Parks and Recreation Committee continue to ensure that planning for parks and leisure events and activities are inclusive of and promote the “generations together” theme.
2. That awareness of the Generations Together theme be incorporated into Community Boards’ Strengthening Communities Action Plans.
3. That a further meeting of the Working Party be held in September 2000 to review events held during the year and to formulate bids for the 2001/02 financial year.
