

5. PARKS CAPITAL WORKS PROGRAMME 1999/2000

Progress on parks capital projects within Shirley/Papanui were contained in a report from the Parks Unit, as well as information on a project where funding was to be reallocated. The Area Parks Officer made a verbal report on the acceptance of the tender for the construction of the St Albans Park concrete skateboard ramp. Members expressed concerns that a facility enabling it to be locked was not included in the project.

The Board **decided:**

1. That the information be received.
2. That noise monitoring be undertaken over two weeks in St Albans Park, while the temporary ramp was still on the site and again following completion of the permanent ramp.
3. That the Parks Unit investigate ways of locking the concrete ramp at nights.
