5. PARKS CAPITAL WORKS PROGRAMME 1999/2000

Progress on parks capital projects within Shirley/Papanui were contained in a report from the Parks Unit, as well as information on a project where funding was to be reallocated. The Area Parks Officer made a verbal report on the acceptance of the tender for the construction of the St Albans Park concrete skateboard ramp. Members expressed concerns that a facility enabling it to be locked was not included in the project.

The Board decided:

- 1. That the information be received.
- 2. That noise monitoring be undertaken over two weeks in St Albans Park, while the temporary ramp was still on the site and again following completion of the permanent ramp.
- 3. That the Parks Unit investigate ways of locking the concrete ramp at nights.
