

13. PURCHASE OF RESERVE - PAMIR STREET

A report from the Water Services and Property Units proposing that the Parks and Recreation Committee consider the purchase of a property to create a reserve bounding Dudley Creek in Pamir Street was referred for comment. The Board **received** the information.

As there had been a problem with graffiti in the area, members suggested that the Parks Unit distribute a leaflet to local residents recommending the Adopt a Park scheme with the aim of keeping a watch on the area, and also seek school involvement in the scheme.
