### 2. STRENGTHENING COMMUNITY ACTION PLAN (SCAP)

The Community Development Adviser reported the outcome of the SCAP project as identified by the Core Group and sought approval for its recommendations to allocate the funding assigned to the project.

#### The Board decided:

#### 1. Graffiti

That Te Kaupapa Whakaora be allocated \$4,000 towards a graffiti-busting project, and that an update memorandum be supplied to the Board members in three months, with a report to the Board meeting in six months.

### 2. Youth Needs

- 1. That the St Albans Residents' Association (SARA) be allocated \$3,000 towards youth activities/programmes in the Shirley area, to be utilised by the Youth Worker employed by SARA.
- 2. That the Northlands Youth Worker Advisory Group be allocated \$10,000 towards overheads and activities for youth in the Northlands area.

## 3. "Boil Up" Programme

That the "Boil Up" programme be allocated \$20,000 towards its costs and that an application be supported for funding from the Crime Prevention funding administered by the Prime Minister's office.

Robin Booth asked that his vote be recorded against the above decision.

### 4. School Safety

That a Working Party comprising Myra Barry, Dennis Hills and Yvonne Palmer look at implementing recommendations from Tim Ashton's report.

# 5. **Delta Community Trust**

That \$11,140 be allocated to the "Live to the Max" scheme run by the Delta Community Trust.
