The purpose of this report is to start the legal procedures necessary to stop a portion of legal road.

With the upgrading of Arthur Barnetts Department Store permission was granted by the Council for the developer to retain the old facade of the old building on legal road.

It is now appropriate to stop the portion of legal road that is occupied by the structure and amalgamate the stopped road with the adjoining certificate of title.

Negotiations between Council officers and the adjoining land owners have been satisfactorily concluded subject to a successful road stopping procedure.

The City Streets Unit agrees with this proposal.

The land is not formed as road but occupied by the adjoining owners. The plan is <u>attached</u>. Prior to selling the land the following resolution is necessary to initiate the stopping action:

RESOLUTION

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 116 & 117 of the Public Works Act 1981, the Christchurch City Council hereby resolves to stop that portion of road as shown on the plan and described in the Schedule hereto.

REASON FOR THE ROAD STOPPING

In order to preserve the facade of the old building the Council agreed to the structure being located on the legal road.

PURPOSE TO WHICH THE STOPPED ROAD WILL BE PUT

The portion of road when stopped, will be sold to the adjoining owners pursuant to Section 345(1)(a)(i) of the Local Government Act 1974 and amalgamated with their certificate of title pursuant to Section 345(2) of the Local Government Act 1974.

The land is situated alongside and occupied by Arthur Barnetts Limited and is 0.40 m in width.
