

15. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

15.1 BERNARD FOLEY – JOHNSON’S FISH NURSERY AND COMMUNITY WATCH CAR

Mr Bernard Foley addressed the Board urging the commemoration of the former Johnson’s Fish Nursery by naming some feature of the area after the proprietor of this Fish Nursery. The nursery was in the area bounded by Sheldon Street, Marshall Street and Clarendon Terrace in the 1890’s. Mr Foley had suggested that this stretch of the river could be named “Johnson’s Reach”.

The Board **resolved** that Aaron O’Brien, John Freeman and Linda Rutland be appointed to a working party to progress this matter and to come back to the Board with a recommendation.

Mr Foley also requested the Board’s support for the running costs of the Community Watch car. This matter is dealt with under correspondence.
