15. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

15.3 IRINKA BRITNELL

Irinka Britnell addressed the Board on two matters:

- (a) the soil shed in Beverley Park and
- (b) a request for funding for reimbursement of expenses incurred in preparing materials for the Heritage Rose Garden project.

Ms Britnell expressed concerns at the possible "blighting" effect on the landscape of Beverley Park which the Bowling Club soil shed would have if it were constructed. She expressed concerns at the possible size of the shed and whether it needed to be a large shed and requested consultation on the location of the soil shed before the site was finally determined. The Board noted that the Bowling Club has not thus far requested approval to build this soil shed.

Ms Britnell also expressed concerns that the copper beach tree in Worcester Street outside the backpackers shop had died and asked if it could be replaced.

It was left to the Area Parks Officer to investigate this and to arrange for replanting if possible.

The Board **resolved** to reimburse to the Englefield Residents' Association the costs of \$490 incurred in promoting the Heritage Rose Garden project from the Board's 2000/01 Discretionary Fund.

In the voting on this resolution there was an equality of votes. The resolution was declared "Carried" on the Chairman's casting vote in support of the resolution.
