26. ASIAN YOUTH

A report from the Community Development Advisers from the Papanui and Sockburn Service Centres provided up-to-date information on the Asian youth research project. One of the major recommendations of the research was the employment of an Asian Youth Co-ordinator. This position had been developed by the Working Party and an appointment made in May.

The Board **resolved:**

- 1. That the information be received.
- 2. That Community Board representatives continue to attend Working Party meetings and that its administration and venues be shared evenly between the Board areas.
- 3. That a member of staff from each Advocacy Team attend all meetings to ensure co-ordination of information.
- 4. That all Board funding allocated for 'Outcome of Asian Youth Research' go towards supporting the Asian Youth Co-ordinator Project. (Total amount 2000/01 Riccarton/Wigram \$3,000; Shirley/Papanui \$3,000.)
- 5. That, upon further investigation and reporting, Board funding be allocated towards topping up the Asian Youth Co-ordinator salary to an appropriate level.
- 6. That groups or organisations targeting Asian youth be directed to the normal process of accessing Community Board funds.
- 7. That consideration be given to the establishment of a Management Committee comprising one member from each of the three Boards, three Asian representatives, representatives from the Chinese Church in Avonhead and appropriate staff.
