



2. REVIEW OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND SOCIAL WELLBEING POLICY

The purpose of this report was to put before the Board a draft of the Social Wellbeing Policy and Community Policy and process guidelines for feedback and endorsement.

Suggestions made by the Board during the presentation included:

- The inclusion of a link to the City Plan process, promoting community responsibility for the common good, and that the “unvoiced” be given every assistance;
- That the “pathway team” be renamed;
- That a balance between the rights and responsibilities of the community be included as an objective; and
- That the position of the reference to the Treaty of Waitangi on the outcomes list be reconsidered.

The Board **decided** that the Community Services Committee be advised that the Spreydon/Heathcote Community Board recommends that the draft policy and guidelines, incorporating the Board’s comments, be adopted.
