21. REVIEW OF BASIS OF 2001 LOCAL BODY ELECTIONS - COMMUNITY BOUNDARIES AND COMMUNITY BOARD MEMBERSHIP

The Council Secretary requested Boards to consider any possible changes in community boundaries and/or Community Board membership, which could be implemented at the next Christchurch City elections in October 2001. The Board **resolved:**

- 1. That the number of elected Community Board representatives remain the same as present.
- 2. That having reviewed the submissions made by other Boards and Residents' Associations during the review of ward boundaries last year, that:
 - (a) Janet Stewart Reserve remain in the Burwood ward, ie the Styx River remain as the boundary with Papanui rather than Lower Styx Road.
 - (b) Marshland Road remain in the Burwood boundary so that the Golf Links Residents' Group area stays in the Burwood/Pegasus area.
 - (c) The Pegasus ward boundary with Hagley ward remain at Kerrs Road.
 - (d) Approval be sought for the Pegasus boundary with Ferrymead to be shifted westwards to take in Cuthberts Green/Cowles Stadium/Waste Treatment Plan/Oxidation Ponds and the eastern side of the Avon/Heathcote Estuary (including Pleasant Point Yacht Club).
