



### 3. CORRESPONDENCE RECEIVED FROM COMMERCE COMMISSION

The Subcommittee considered a letter from the Commerce Commission regarding the Canterbury Regional Landfill joint venture project in which the Commission advised that following their investigation, and on the information available to date, there was insufficient evidence to establish a breach of section 27 of the Act. A copy of the correspondence from the Commerce Commission is attached.

The Subcommittee **received** the information and noted that TransWaste Canterbury Ltd was currently engaging specialist legal counsel to develop a strategy to deal with all Commerce Commission issues in a timely and comprehensive way. This would undoubtedly involve an application for an authorisation under the Commerce Act, which would formally satisfy the potential concerns mentioned in the letter.
