11. ATTLEE CRESCENT STREET TREES

The Committee considered a report on the recommendation of the Subcommittee appointed at the May meeting of the City Services Committee to comment on the proposed course of action for dealing with fruiting plum trees in Attlee Crescent.

The Subcommittee consisting of Councillors Denis O'Rourke, Carole Evans, Ron Wright and the Chairman of the Fendalton/Waimairi Community Board met on site on Friday 12 May 2000 and supported the recommendations of the Fendalton/Waimairi Community Board with the exception that it considered the channels and carriageways should be swept on a one weekly, rather than two weekly cycle during the fruiting season.

The Committee **resolved**:

- 1. The existing healthy trees are retained for the remainder of their serviceable life.
- 2. The existing street trees are replaced with a non-fruiting tree of the same species when they become diseased or die.
- 3. Attlee Crescent's channels and carriageway be swept on a one weekly cycle during the fruiting season.
- 4. That the above measures be reviewed in April 2001.
- 5. That the residents be informed of the above outcomes.
- 6. That an approach be made to groups and organisations that might be interested in picking the plums.
