13. PURCHASE OF LAND FOR RICCARTON WATER SUPPLY PUMP STATION

The Committee considered a report on the purchase of land to construct a water supply pump station to replace the existing stations at Clarence and Mandeville Streets.

The report had also been referred to the Riccarton/Wigram Community Board for its comment and the Board had supported the purchase of land in Picton Avenue as recommended the report.

The report detailed the three options for a new pumping station together with costs and advantages and noted that the preferred site in Picton Avenue would allow for reduced costs and reticulation and joint development with Parks Unit of adjacent land.

Appropriate allowance for land purchase had been made in the Water Services 1999/2000 budget.

The Committee **resolved**:

- 1. That the purchase of 61 Picton Ave being the land contained in Certificate of Title 37C/166 be approved at the settlement figure included in the public excluded section of this report.
- 2. That the site be developed as a utility reserve in conjunction with adjoining land purchased for reserve purposes.
