6. RICCARTON/WIGRAM WORKS AND TRAFFIC COMMITTEE REPORT OF 26 MAY 2000

The Board was in receipt of the outcomes of the Works and Traffic Committee meeting held on 26 May 2000.

1. ENVIRONMENT CANTERBURY: REVIEW OF WESTERN BUS SERVICES

The Committee received a presentation on how the following issues were being handled by Environment Canterbury (Ms J M Atkinson and Mr W Houlton-Jeffries were present).

- (a) service improvement
- (b) trip times/frequencies
- (c) new services
- (d) Board assistance in the public consultation process

2. HARAKEKE STREET – ON STREET PARKING AND ASSOCIATED TRAFFIC ISSUES

An on site meeting was held with representatives of the Riccarton Kidsfirst Kindergarten and Mr C Mangos, for the kindergarten, was in attendance at the Works and Traffic Committee meeting.

The kindergarten had identified safety issues due to the lack of parking in the immediate vicinity and traffic speed. They were asking for assistance to address these issues.

The Board **decided**:

- 1. To have Council staff investigate the principle of angle parking along the western side of Harakeke Street, between Jane Deans Close/ Service Lane and Kilmarnock Street.
- 2. To ask that appropriate signage be placed alerting traffic to the presence of the kindergarten.
- 3. To support the kerb and channel replacement along this section of Harakeke Street.
