

18. COMMUNITY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

It was **resolved** that the recommendations of the Community Affairs Committee meeting held on 16 May 2000 be adopted as follows:

18.1. ACC Injury Prevention Programme – “Down With Speed”

That the Board make a submission to the Police advocating the enforcement of **all** speed limits, not just vehicles travelling within the 10km range above the speed limit.

18.2 Local Community Gathering Events: Community Fun Day at Barrington Park & Hoon Hay Community Day

1. That Manuka Cottage be approached to facilitate the organisation of the 2001 Barrington Community Day.
2. That the newly formed Hoon Hay Community Network be approached to oversee the organisation of the 2001 Hoon Hay Community Day.
3. That the Board increase its level of funding for each event to \$3,500, from the 2000/2001 Discretionary Fund.

18.5 Submissions to the Draft 2000/01 Annual Plan

The Committee had been granted delegated authority at the Board's 2 May 2000 meeting to prepare submissions to the Council's draft 2000/01 Annual Plan.

The Committee **resolved** to prepare a submission on the following issues:

1. Funding for replacement of the Takahe toilets
2. Support the “Field Worker in Schools” project and request funding for the ongoing evaluation of the project.
3. The need for angle parking in Spencer Street, Addington.
4. Support the additional \$50,000 provided to community boards to be used towards the funding of community development worker positions within community organisations.
5. Reinforce the “Garden City” image by creating colourful flower beds throughout the inner city and hanging baskets in the Square.

6. Parks Unit to be responsible for the planting of berms etc rather than the City Streets Unit.
7. Riverbank maintenance.
8. Business Liaison Person.
9. Review of the current parking situation in the area around Hagley Park netball courts.

18.6 Neighbourhood Week 2000

That the Board allocate \$2,500 from its 2000/01 Discretionary Fund towards Neighbourhood Week 2000 activities.
