



5. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

Since the order paper for this meeting had been prepared, three additional requests for speaking rights had been received. The Board **agreed** to hear these additional deputations.

5.1 Englefield Residents' Association

Mrs Irinka Britnell, Secretary of the Englefield Residents' Association, addressed the Board outlining the need for the protection of the whole of the Englefield area from redevelopment.

Mrs Britnell invited Community Board members to come on a "walk-about" of the Englefield area in order to assess the proposals placed before the Board by this deputation.

5.2 Richmond Neighbourhood Cottage

Mr Graham Reddell and Mrs Margaret Cockburn of the Richmond Neighbourhood Cottage addressed the Board expressing their concern at the proposals by the Department of Corrections to establish a Periodic Detention Centre at 232 Stanmore Road. Mr Reddell stated that no consultation had taken place with the community. The objections related to the busy and dangerous corner (Stanmore Road and Swanns Road) with restricted parking and the difficulty of exit for the vans taking detainees out to their tasks and appealed to the Board to support them in their appeal against this proposal.

5.3 Moncks Spur Road – Land Exchange

The solicitor for Mr Fox, one of the parties involved in the proposed Moncks Spur Road land exchange, requested that the Board defer consideration of this matter until later in the meeting in the hope that agreement could be reached with all concerned parties before the conclusion of this meeting.

The Board **agreed** that this matter be deferred for consideration later in the meeting.
