22. SUMNER OUT OF SCHOOL PROGRAMME WORKING PARTY

The Board considered a report from the Sumner Out of School Programme Working Party appointed by the Board to consider the funding needs of the Sumner Out of School Programme.

The report outlined the deliberations of the Working Party and a summary of the relevant issues which were considered.

The Working Party had decided:

- 1. To offer to underwrite funding of up to \$2,500 to support the Sumner Out of School Programme up to 31 March 2000 from the Board's 1999/2000 Discretionary Fund.
- 2. To reconvene this working party towards the end of March 2000 to consider the issues of ongoing funding, location and future viability and that this coming meeting of the Working Party be held on site in the Sumner School Hall.

The Board **resolved:**

- 1. That the decisions of the Working Party, as outlined above, be confirmed.
- 2. That a report be prepared for the Community Services Committee outlining the need for an Out of School Programme for the Sumner area.
