1. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

KIMIHIA TRUST

Ms Nan Caldwell, Secretary/Treasurer of the Kimihia Trust, a Trust set up to support the Linwood High School in its post-secondary school programme, run in conjunction with the New Zealand Army, addressed the Board seeking support for this programme. The NZ Army has previously provided its services free of charge, but this year will charge for the accommodation used by course participants.

These courses provide leadership training and confidence building skills. It is not possible to charge the course participants with the real costs of providing these training courses.

Ms Caldwell was also seeking support for similar courses for a younger group of students, those disruptive to the school programme and at-risk.

ART IN INDUSTRY

Mr Andrew Drummond, representing Art and Industry, addressed the Board outlining the proposal for a sculptural tide—measuring device in the Heathcote River at Woolston that this group would be seeking funding for.
