

## 2. PRIORITISATION OF ACTIVITIES FOR PROJECT FUNDING

The Board agreed to allocate amounts to each area of requests and to prioritise the activities needed in the community rather than the requests received. The Board agreed to assess the project requests and to delete those which were not seen by the Board as priorities.

The Board **resolved**:

1. That \$10,000 of the balance remaining in the 1999/2000 discretionary fund be applied to meet project fund allocations for the 2000/2001 financial year.
2. That the sum of \$20,000 allocated to the SCAP Project but not spent, be carried forward and reallocated as part of the Board's Project Funds.
3. That the Project Funds be allocated to each area according to the following percentages:

City Streets	15%	\$42,000
Parks	15%	\$42,000
Leisure	25%	\$70,000
Community Development	<u>45%</u>	<u>\$126,000</u>
	100%	\$280,000
