



## 2. RICCARTON/WIGRAM FINANCE AND POLICY COMMITTEE REPORT OF 16 FEBRUARY 2000 MEETING

The Board received a report on the Committee meeting held on 16 February 2000. (At its 2 February meeting the Community Board gave this Committee **power to act** in respect of allocating its 2000/01 Project and Discretionary Funds.)

Members were in receipt of a full schedule of projects.

It was noted that two high priority projects (Hornby Youth Worker and the Riccarton Youth Worker subsidy) had received support from the Community Services Committee Annual Plan meeting, by way of half-funding.

Members were mindful that the retention of these recommended funds still had to pass through the ongoing phases of the Council draft Annual Plan process (to 6 July 2000).

Exercising its “power to act” the Committee allocated the funds, as follows:
