10. BELFAST ROAD - SCHOOL CROSSING ISLAND

Further to the report considered at the February meeting the Area Engineer reported, seeking approval for the construction of a pedestrian island for children attending the Belfast Primary School. A site visit was made on 16 February by Board members and Road Safety for Schools steering group representatives to observe the situation.

The Board **decided** that it be recommended to the City Services Committee:

- 1. That a pedestrian island be installed in Belfast Road to the east of the intersection with Shannon Place.
- 2. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited on the southern side of Belfast Road commencing at its intersection with Shannon Place and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 36 metres.
- 3. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited on the northern side of Belfast Road commencing opposite the eastern kerb-line of Shannon Place and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 39 metres.
- 4. That a footpath be provided in Shannon place on the side that currently does not have a footpath.
