



5. RECOGNITION OF EFFORTS IN RESIDENTIAL GARDENS

A report by Dennis Hills, Deputy Chairperson, sought an extension to the present system of awarding garden certificates. It was envisaged that this might include cases of beautification in areas that were not in the same class as those chosen for awards, but were worthy of some form of recognition to encourage continuation of their efforts. The Board **decided** that a report be prepared by staff for the 29 March meeting, outlining the present scope of awards and the likely costs of an extension to those schemes to include several hundred gardens worthy of praise, if not of a formal award.
