# PART C - REPORT ON DELEGATED DECISIONS TAKEN BY THE BOARD

#### 1. PROJECT FUNDING ALLOCATIONS FOR 2000/2001

The Board considered schedules of projects for consideration in allocating its \$300,000 Project Funds for 2000/01.

It was noted that holiday programmes were not included in the total cost of \$38,000 for the Northcote After School Programme.

#### The Board **resolved**:

- 1. That \$50,000 be allocated for discretionary funds.
- 2. That the schedule of Project Fund allocations (as attached) be adopted.
- 3. That assistance be given to the Christchurch North Citizens Advice Bureau Inc to seek sponsorship for the balance of \$5,000 of the requested funding, but that this be considered from 2000/01 discretionary funds if required.
- 4. That the balance of \$3,000 to provide the Shirley After School Care be approved from 2000/01 discretionary funds if sponsorship not found.
- 5. That the request for a light in the Packe Street Reserve at a cost of \$2,000 be considered by a future meeting of the Community Board for allocation from discretionary funds.
