



#### 4. NEIGHBOURHOOD IMPROVEMENT WORKS PROGRAMMING

The Board considered a report informing it of the changes to the prioritisation process for Neighbourhood Improvement Works.

The Board **decided** to:

1. Receive the information.
2. Support the current allocation for 2000/01 which is unchanged from the previous year.
3. Request that Council not deal with Neighbourhood Improvement Works programmes on roads in isolation from other improvements, ie parks, waterways, undergrounding etc.
4. Submit to Council that it would prefer to see constrained funds spent on practical projects rather than on consultants' fees, and that wherever possible, Council staff be used ahead of consultants.
