18. RESIDENTS' ASSOCIATIONS

NORTH NEW BRIGHTON RESIDENTS' ASSOCIATION

Craig Singleton was in attendance to request that measures be put in place to allow for minimal disruption of Thomson Park when tree felling and landscape works were undertaken by the Council. Mr Singleton believed that measures should consider irrigation, conditioning and replanting of trees as well as amenity changes to the park, such as terracing of the amphitheatre, creation of a path through a park and relocation of the flying fox and swings. Mr Singleton's main concerns were timelines for the felling of trees and removal of stumps and roots, irrigation and the future use of felled timber. Mr Singleton tabled a letter outlining his concerns, which the Board **decided** to refer to the Parks Unit for its consideration.
