

27. RICHMOND HILL ROAD - STREET TREE REMOVAL

The Committee considered a report on the recommendations of the subcommittee formed at the City Services Committee meeting on 4 April 2000 to consider the removal and replacement of plane trees in Richmond Hill Road.

A subcommittee consisting of the Chairman and Councillors Wright and Evans and the Chairman of the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board was appointed to consider the matter on site and report back to the next meeting of the Committee.

The Chairman, Councillors Wright and Baker (Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board) met on site on Wednesday 5 April 2000 and recommended that the trees should be removed as resolved by the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board.

The Committee **resolved** that all 15 of the existing plane trees in Richmond Hill Road and Nayland Street (from Wakefield Avenue to Marriner Street) be removed and replaced with a suitable smaller growing species.
