25. ROAD - NEW BRIGHTON MALL

The Committee considered a report from the Chairman, Councillor Denis O'Rourke, concerning the one-way slow road to be constructed in New Brighton Mall as far east as Oram Avenue as resolved by the Council in February 2000.

The Committee **resolved**:

- 1. To appoint a subcommittee of Councillors, to be known as The New Brighton Mall Road Subcommittee, for the following purposes:
 - (a) To examine in consultation with the working party the options for the connection of the eastern end of the proposed new road with either the Hawke Street car park or Beresford Street via Oram Avenue.
 - (b) To conduct discussions (with the assistance of relevant Council officers) with business proprietors and property owners having businesses/property in the vicinity of the eastern end of the proposed new road.
 - (c) To consider in consultation with the working party the design and characteristics for the proposed new slow road.
 - (d) To develop in consultation with the working party a report on these matters for the Committee to enable it to make recommendations to the Council.
- 2. That the Committee appoint the Chairman and Councillors Close, Wright and Evans to comprise the subcommittee.
- 3. That the subcommittee hold its first meeting on Tuesday 16 May 2000 at 12noon, and that staff provide an update of the situation to the meeting and their advice on how best to proceed to achieve the purposes detailed in recommendation 1 above.
