



4. ENTRANCE BARRIERS TO GENERAL PARKS AND ACCESSWAYS

In a report from the Cycle Planner, the views of the Board were sought towards the opening up of general park and accessways entrances to improve access for cyclists, wheelchair and pushchair users within the Board's area.

The Board was concerned to ensure that any changes to the status quo in any given situation did not compromise user safety. This related in particular to cyclists who would have no restriction to speed as they intersected with the roadway. A suggested option could be to set back one of the staples rather than remove it totally.

The Board therefore was not supportive of a carte blanche removal programme and requested that any planned removals in its area come before the Board for consideration in the first instance.

The Board **decided** therefore to refer the above comments to the City Services Committee.
