23. COMMUNITY ADVOCATE'S UPDATE

(a) SUMNER SURF LIFE SAVING CLUB

A letter of congratulation had been forwarded to the Club on behalf of the Community Board to mark the winning of the National Inshore Reserve Boat Championships and several other awards as well.

(b) IT'S GREAT TO LIVE HERE CELEBRATION

The Board noted that the "It's Great to Live Here" Celebration in support of Bromley, Linwood, Woolston and Phillipstown was being repeated again this year between 2 and 5 August 2000.

(c) DISCRETIONARY EXPENDITURE

The Board considered a schedule outlining the Board's discretionary expenditure allocations to date and showing credits for grants returned or not uplifted. A total of \$4,083 remained.

The Board also noted that the unspent balance of the grant of \$3,000 made on 3 November 1999 to Heritage Youth Inc for the Brockworth Homestead Project had been returned as Heritage Youth Inc has retired from this project.
