16. COMMUNITY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

The Board **resolved** that the recommendations of the Community Affairs Committee meeting held on 18 April 2000 be adopted as follows:

16.1 Boons Neighbourhood Action Group

That the Board grant \$700 from its 1999/2000 Discretionary Fund to the Boons Neighbourhood Action Group.

16.2 St Martins Scout Funding Request

The the Board support (in principle) an application for \$7,500, subject to a favourable report back being received in terms of the legal status of the land, and resource consent requirements.

16.3 Project Funds Carry Forward – Art in the Local Area

- 1. That a request be made to Council to carry forward the \$3,000 set aside for "Art in the Local Area".
- 2. That a sub committee be formed (comprising Carole Anderton, Phil Clearwater, and Lynda Carter) with a view to making recommendations regarding the spending of this money, prior to 30 June 2000.

16.4 Review of Implementation and Priorities of the Community Development and Social Well-Being Policy

That the Board:

- 1. Note the review process for the Community Development and Social Well-Being Policy.
- 2. Endorse the proposed seminar.

16.5 Field Worker in Schools

That the Board request the Strategy and Resources Committee to consider further funding for ongoing evaluation of the project.

16.6 Amended Community Board Funding Policy 2000/01 - Allocation of Project Funds

That the Board:

- 1. Adopt the proposed project fund schedule attached to the Community Affairs Committee agenda of 18 April 2000 (attachment to clause 6).
- 2. Allocate the balance of \$15,000 to Community Worker Support (being consistent with the new Board Funding Policy, and allowing staff to come back at a later date outlining possible opportunities including clear performance indicators, outcome expectations and reporting requirements).
