



3. PARKS CAPITAL WORKS PROGRAMME

The Board considered a report informing it of progress on parks capital projects within the Board's area as at 15 April 2000.

The Board **decided**:

1. That the information be received.
2. That the \$25,000 set aside for play equipment upgrading at Curries Reserve be reallocated for the provision of play equipment at Hillsborough Domain, subject to the current equipment at Curries Road meeting Health and Safety standards.
3. That staff be encouraged to inspect the junior playground located at the Opawa School with a view to considering a similar design.
