

### 13. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

#### (c) MR DEREK McCULLOUGH - ADVENTURE PLAYGROUND

Mr McCullough spoke regarding the adventure playground proposed for Sunday 18 March 2001 which would involve the racing of jiggers on the tram tracks from the Cathedral Junction to the Arts Centre together with a number of other adventure-related events such as high wire walking, adventure rides, adventure food etc. Mr McCullough indicated that he saw this as an icon event for Christchurch and sought the assistance of the Council in preparing a traffic management plan for the event.

The Committee **decided:**

1. That the City Streets Unit prepare a traffic management plan for 'The Adventure Playground' event as one of the Council's contributions to it, incorporating the issues identified in Mr McCullough's paper, including the temporary closure of the necessary parts of Montreal and Durham/Cambridge one-way streets.
2. That the cost of implementation of the plan be entirely the liability of the event organisers.
