20. STREET "BURN OUT" PROBLEM

Councillor Stonhill reported verbally on her discussions with the Hornby Police as part of the working party to examine street disorder. Councillor Stonhill indicated that the Police were intending to implement a programme over some three weeks of sending letters to the owners of cars participating in the burn outs in the Hornby areas in an attempt to remove those vehicles belonging to either parents or companies which are being used without proper consent.

It was noted that the Police resources, however, did not allow for this campaign to extend for more than three weeks and Councillor Stonhill sought additional financial assistance to allow the City Council to take over the programme for a longer period.

It was decided:

- 1. That the Road Safety Co-ordinator and the City Streets Manager confer on providing resources to enable the implementation of a monitoring programme as discussed.
- 2. That the City Streets Manager discuss the legal implications of the Council operating such a programme.
- 3. That the motor vehicles identified follow-up with the motor vehicle owners be instituted on Christchurch City Council letterhead.
