6. COWLISHAW STREET PARKING

The Board considered a report seeking approval for the installation of either parking ticks or a parking restriction in a section of Cowlishaw Street.

In the discussion which took place on this matter, the Board expressed a view that it should be seeking a long-term solution to the problem.

The Board **decided**:

- 1. That a community meeting be set up to seek acceptable solutions to this problem and that this community meeting involve the Cowlishaw Street-Patten Street Residents' Society, the Avonside Girls' High School, Tim Barnett MP, Hagley Ward Community Board members and Council planning staff. (The possibility of the private VSI College being involved in these discussions at a later stage was also referred to).
- 2. That the traffic engineers be asked to look at a bigger picture than just Cowlishaw Street and to advise the Board of the flow-on effects on to other streets in the vicinity of Cowlishaw Street and on to the Avon River bank.
- 3. That, in the interim, parking enforcement be carried out as a short-term measure in Cowlishaw Street.
