

2. **COLOMBO STREET – TIME LIMIT PARKING AT DAIRY**

The purpose of this report is to seek Council approval for the installation of a P5 Loading Zone on the west side of Colombo Street to the north of Purchas Street.

Long term parking is spreading further along streets in the area between Bealey Avenue and Edgeware. Customers wanting to shop at Pah’s Dairy near the corner of Purchas Street are finding it difficult to find a place to stop. There has been a P30 time limit zone at this location for more than 30 years but this duration is proving to be too long for the use of the dairy which is the only shop now operating at this location.

The dairy owner has requested that a shorter term parking zone be created across the frontage of the property. Similar P5 loading zones have been created on two corners at the Canon Street intersection and have been operating efficiently. This modification will bring uniformity to the restrictions in this block of Colombo Street.

This part of Colombo Street is classified as collector road.

Recommendation: That the Council pass the following resolution:

Resolution

That a Loading Zone time limit of 5 minutes be created on the western side of Colombo Street commencing at a point 23 metres north of the northern kerb with Purchas Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 13 metres.
