15. REDCLIFFS SCHOOL PEDESTRIAN CROSSING

The Committee considered a report from Barry Cook, Area Engineer, on the proposal to shift the pedestrian crossing on the main road at Redcliffs School.

The report recommended the relocation of the existing pedestrian crossing by approximately 27 metres to provide separation from the vehicle entrance to the school.

The report noted that a safety audit for the proposal had yet to be carried out, public consultation was yet to take place and design finalised.

The Committee **resolved**:

- 1. That the information be received.
- 2. That \$60,000 from the Road Safety at Schools budget be spent on relocating the crossing facility in the Main Road outside Redcliffs School, by shifting it a distance of approx 27m towards Sumner.
- 3. That a formal undertaking be obtained from the Redcliffs School that the school will fund a pedestrian footpath within the school grounds, and the widening of the entranceway, so that all work is completed at the same time.
