2. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

a) TI RAKAU DRIVE BUS STOP

Mr Kelly Wood addressed the Board advising that he had moved into his property in Ti Rakau Drive only three months previously and so had missed earlier discussion on bus stop locations. The first notification he had received that a bus stop was proposed outside his property was three weeks previously. Mr Wood submitted a letter to the Board urging the Board to seek an alternative site for the bus stop proposed outside his property and supported this letter with a letter from a medical practitioner advising that his partner needed rest and freedom from stress and disturbance.

Mr Wood submitted:

- (a) That the location of the bus stop outside his property would be an invasion of his privacy and would be detrimental to his wife's health and
- (b) That he needed the parking area in front of his house for his work vehicles and to ensure their safety.
