### (e) **Packe Street Park Eucalyptus**

Bill Sykes made a plea to the Board to support the protection of a manna gum behind Packe Street Park. The tree is not rare in Canterbury but adds a dimension to the Park that is poorly developed in the area. The Parks Officer told the Board that in his experience, the City Plan people who were responsible for protecting trees, were not willing to put trees such as this on the list.
