15. HILLARY COMMISSION COMMUNITY SPORT FUND CHANGES

The Leisure Manager reported on recently announced changes to the above scheme for the 2000/01 year.

The Commission proposes to introduce a club development policy aimed at encouraging the rationalisation of sports clubs and the formation of multi sports clubs.

The Commission has reduced its per capital allocation in 2000/01 from \$1.23 to \$1.15 per head of population. The Council's allocation will be \$372,945 a reduction of \$25,944 on the present allocation.

The Committee **decided**:

- 1. That the information be received.
- 2. That publicity be given to the club development policy so that clubs can give consideration to the development options before the 2000/01 funding round.
